"What they wanted, and what we got," claims Mr. Schneider, "was more easily controllable provincial administrative units. Now people are more removed from political power than ever before."

"The Tories have greater control over local government because they have never attempted to reform local government, and as costs inevitably go up, the local politician faces an increasingly dissatisfied local voter."

In answer to the Tory policies, Mr. Schneider presented the NDP political stand. We must place an absolute moratorium on the establishment of any additional regional governments, until locally directed studies can be completed, evaluating the performance of regional government.

Using the results of these studies, and whatever other data seems appropriate, local people should be allowed to further reform their government, learn it, as it is, and make major changes where necessary."

Where local governments do not now exist, legislation

should be introduced, allowing local people to take the initiative, to do the research, and make the decisions, whenever, and if ever, they choose.

The base of municipal finances must be reformed.

Finally, and perhaps as important as any of the others, is the need for an

official plan for Ontario. Local governments of any type cannot function and plan responsibly in the absence of an overall plan for Ontario.
