Present were Gordon Laidlaw, chairman; Margaret Payne, secretary; Graydon Field, treasurer; Dan O'Dwyer, Frances Bergen, Paul Zaluski, Norma Savory, Phil Hare, City of Nanticoke representatives. Joyce Lindsay, Niagara Regional Library System Board representative; the three librarians — Glen Bell, Waterford; Norma Cosley, Port Dover; Teddy Abbott, Selkirk. One member was absent.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted. Some of the repairs and painting on the buildings and equipment have been completed. The Port Dover building looks very fresh with the new colour scheme. The work at Waterford has yet to be started.

The bills from the three libraries were presented.

There was a realignment of committee members. Mr. Field withdrew from personnel in favour of the financial committee. Norma Savory went to personnel.

The next meeting will be May 12th in the Waterford Library.

Moved by Paul Zaluski and seconded by Frances Bergen that these be paid. The treasurer's report was presented. At the present, we are operating on a deficit budget, as the grants will not come through till later in the year. The clerk of the city has advised that there are Gestetners available for the use of the libraries, from the old municipal offices.

There was further discussion of the insurance, and the libraries were reminded to prepare an inventory. Holiday time for the staffs was discussed, and an agreement reached.
