Section 2, Paragraph 6

Woodhouse by-law No. 842-71

"No person shall convey material, garbage, refuse or waste to the sanitary landfill site in such a manner that the wind may cause it to blow from the vehicle or conveyance on which or by which it is being transported or in such a manner as to leave deposits along the road;"

Any person convicted of an offense under this by-law is subject to a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) exclusive of costs for each such offence.
